Dear Sir/Madam:

Effective July 1, 2010, the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority will implement the new ESCA Exhibition Industry Worker Identification System – WIS for employees of all contractors that perform work in the building servicing meetings and exhibitions. This new identification badge system will allow the LVCVA to track who is working in the building at any given time, thereby improving the overall security of the facilities, its tenants and their guests.

Effective July 1, 2010, all exhibition workers will be asked to have the ESCA WIS Badge, and effective November 10, 2010 no exhibition worker will be allowed to work on site at the LVCVA facilities, the Las Vegas Convention Center and Cashman Center without the ESCA WIS Badge.

The Exhibition Services & Contractors Association (ESCA) has been retained by the LVCVA to administer this program and to maintain an online database of all registered contractors and workers in the local exhibition industry. In order to register and obtain identification badges for your (1) full-time employees and (2) part-time workers, as well as obtain (3) Temporary Access badges for new employees and workers, please follow the link below to start the process.
