

EXHIBITOR AND VISITOR SAFETY TIPS: **KEEPING THE EVENTS WORLD SAFER**

Exhibitor Safety Top 5:

- 1. No standing on furnishings.
- 2. Avoid adapting electrical cords.
- 3. Do not hang items off Pipe and Drape attachments.
- 4. Stay out of empty storage areas during load-out.
- 5. Keep the area clean and tidy.

Standard Show Site Pedestrian Safety:

- 1. Familiarize yourself with the mustering point location in case of emergency evacuation.
- 2. Follow the 5, 10, 15 FT rule: Be aware of your surroundings at 5-, 10-, and 15-feet distances.
- 3. Know the locations of First Aid stations in the venues.
- 4. Avoid distracted walking with cell phones; find a safe place to use your phone.

Forklifts Pedestrian Safety:

- 1. Stay alert and attentive.
- 2. Keep a safe distance from busy freight aisles and dock areas.
- 3. Make eye contact with forklift operators to ensure mutual awareness.

Mobile Ariel Equipment Pedestrian Safety:

- 1. Be aware of your surroundings.
- 2. Avoid walking under elevated work platforms or baskets.
- 3. Walking Surfaces
- 4. Watch your step!
- 5. Be cautious of uneven surfaces, trash, debris, and liquids.

6. Wear closed-toe shoes and choose appropriate footwear for walking surfaces, especially when wearing heels.
